



Immaculate Conception School Uniform Regulations - Dress Code

Wearing our school uniform confirms your attendance at Immaculate Conception School and is a symbol of unity within our community. It is important that you take pride in your appearance by wearing your complete school uniform. Always remember that by wearing it inside and outside of school you are representing ICS and your behavior should be a credit to yourself, your family, and your school. Uniforms should be kept neat and clean at all times.

All students from K through Grade 8 are required to wear the school uniform. All uniforms should be purchased from **Lands' End**, our approved vendor. They offer all the required items as well as a variety of optional items and accessories. Orders may be purchased on line, www.landsend.com/uniforms, or by phone, 800-469-2222. Standard Uniform

Boys (K - Gr. 8): Light Blue Shirt (long or short sleeve), Navy Pants, Black or Brown Belt, School Tie, dark socks, and dark shoes. One of the following options, **with logo**, must be worn: Navy Cardigan or Sweater Vest. Navy Fleece Full-Zip Jacket with logo is optional and may be worn with the standard or summer uniform as weather permits.

Girls (K - Gr. 4): Knee Length School Jumper or Navy Pants, White Blouse (long or short sleeve), Red Cardigan **with logo**, Navy Knee-High Socks or Tights, Dark Flat-Heeled Shoes. Red Fleece Full-Zip Jacket with logo is optional and may be worn with the regular or summer uniform as weather permits. Girls may also wear navy leggings under their jumper if desired. Headbands are available.

Girls (Gr. 5 - Gr. 8): Knee Length School Skirt or Navy Pants, White Blouse (long or short sleeve), Navy Knee-Hi Socks or Tights, Dark Flat-Heeled shoes. One of the following options, **with logo**, must be worn: Red Cardigan or Sweater Vest. Red Fleece Full-Zip Jacket with logo is optional and may be worn with the regular or summer uniform as weather permits. Girls may also wear navy leggings under their skirt if desired. Headbands are available.

Gym Uniform Must be worn on gym day.

Boys (K - Gr. 8): Classic Navy Sweatpants or Athletic Shorts, Classic Navy Sweatshirt w/Logo or Gray Heather Tee shirt w/Logo (short or long sleeve), Solid Color Gray Ankle Socks and Sneakers.

Girls (K - Gr. 8): Burgundy Sweatpants or Classic Navy Athletic Shorts, Burgundy Sweatshirt w/Logo or Gray Heather Tee shirt w/Logo (short or long sleeve), Solid Color Gray Ankle Socks and Sneakers.

Summer Uniform Mandatory

May, June and September (may be extended into October if weather permits).

Boys (K - Gr. 8): Khaki Shorts or Pants, Cobalt Blue Polo **w/Logo** (short or long sleeve), Blue or White Ankle Socks and Sneakers.

Girls (ECP4 - Gr. 8): Khaki Shorts, Pants or Skort, Red Polo **w/Logo** (short or long sleeve), Red or White Ankle Socks and Sneakers.

Guidelines for General Appearance

- Uniforms must be neat and clean and complete uniform is required at all times.
- There will be no substitutes for the proper uniform; no Cargo pants or Cargo shorts, no jean style pants.
- Pants must be worn at the waist and shirts must be neatly tucked into the waistband.
- Pants should not be long enough to touch the floor.
- Skirts and skorts should be long enough to reach the top of the knee.
- When wearing the summer uniform, the complete summer dress code must be adhered to.
- There will be no mixing of regular and summer uniforms.
- Students must wear ICS gym uniforms on the required gym days.
- Students must be neatly groomed and a good personal hygiene routine should be followed daily.
- Hair should be clean and neat at all times.
- Cosmetics, including lip gloss and nail polish are not permitted.
- Hats must be removed when entering the building.
- During winter, students may wear boots to school but must change into school uniform shoes in the classroom.
- Parents will be notified if a child comes to school consistently in an unkempt manner and it is the school's expectation that the matter will be resolved.
- The presence of anything that proclaims a current fad is not permitted.
